Tony Asberry is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States magistrate judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On August 31, 2018, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations that the court grant Plaintiff's motion for leave to amend the complaint, allow Plaintiff to proceed only on cognizable claims, and deny plaintiff's motions for summary judgment. (ECF No. 148.) The magistrate judge allowed the parties fourteen days to object (id. at 30), and the parties filed no objection.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper

3	1. The findings and recommendations issued on August 31, 2018 (ECF No.	148), are
4	ADOPTED in full;	
5	2. Plaintiff's case shall proceed only on these cognizable claims:	
6	a. deliberate-indifference claims under the Eighth Amendment agair	ıst
7	Lozovoy and Relevante;	
8	b. conditions-of-confinement claims under the Eighth Amendment a	gainst
9	Ferris and Godfrey; and	
10	c. retaliation claims under the First Amendment against Ferris and C	odfrey
11	(ECF No. 148, at 7-8, 14-15);	
12	3. All other claims are dismissed;	
13	4. Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment on his claims against defendant	Lozovoy
14	(ECF No. 116) is denied;	
15	5. Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment on his claims against defendant	Relevante
16	(ECF No. 117) is denied;	
17	6. Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment on his claims against defendant	s Ferris
18	and Godfrey (ECF No. 125) is denied; and	
19	7. This matter is referred back to the assigned magistrate judge for further p	roceedings
20	consistent with this order.
