FILE NOTICE OF STATUS ON OR BEFORE  
JUNE 5, 2017

17 On April 7, 2017, the parties filed a stipulation to stay this action to pursue settlement  
18 negotiations. The parties agree that Plaintiff may file a first amended complaint, however,  
19 Plaintiff filed a first amended complaint on January 27, 2017. The Court will approve the  
20 stipulation as it pertains to staying this action to pursue settlement discussions and service on the  
21 Defendants who have not yet been served. However, if a second amended complaint is to be  
22 filed, Plaintiff shall be required to file a stipulation or motion to amend after the stay in this action  
23 is lifted.

25 Accordingly, pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 27 1. This action is stayed for sixty (60) days for the parties to pursue settlement of the  
28 action;

- 2. Plaintiff shall serve Defendants Transunion and Equifax with the first amended complaint within thirty (30) days of the stay being lifted in this action;
- 3. Defendant's Transunion and Equifax shall file an answer or otherwise respond to the first amended complaint within twenty (20) days of service of the first amended complaint; and
- 4. The parties shall submit a report on the status of the settlement negotiations and the continued propriety of the stay on or before June 5, 2017.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
