

1 but that Plaintiff is willing to engage in settlement negotiations. The Court finds good cause in this
2 instance to allow Plaintiff to appear by **video teleconference**. A separate order and writ of habeas
3 corpus ad testificandum will issue concurrently with this order.

4 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 5 1. Plaintiff's motion to have alternative dispute resolution via telephone conference (ECF
6 Nos. 19, 20) is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART;
- 7 2. Counsel for Defendants is required to arrange for the participation of Plaintiff by video
8 conference and shall contact the Courtroom Deputy at (559) 499-5672 to coordinate the
9 video conference no later than October 10, 2017; and
- 10 3. The parties shall submit confidential settlement statements as described in the Court's
11 September 11, 2017 order, (ECF No. 17), no later than October 17, 2017.
