ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS; DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*; AND ORDERING PLAINTIFF TO PAY THE FILING FEE IN FULL
(Docs. 2, 7, 8, 9)
21-DAY DEADLINE

Plaintiff filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* along with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On June 12, 2017, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and Recommendations to deny Plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis* based on his untrue poverty allegation. (Doc. 9.) The Findings and Recommendations were served on Plaintiff on that same date and allowed for objections to be filed within twenty-one days. (*Id.*) More than a month has now lapsed and Plaintiff has not filed any objections.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. the Findings and Recommendations, issued on June 12, 2017 (Doc. 9), are adopted in full;
2. Plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis*, filed on December 19, 2016 (Doc. 2), is DENIED;
3. within twenty-one days of the date of service of this order, Plaintiff is required to pay in full the \$400.00 filing fee for this action; and
4. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order shall result in the dismissal of this action without prejudice.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
