The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge 20 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 21 On June 12, 2017, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and Recommendations to deny 22 Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis based on his untrue poverty allegation. (Doc. 23 9.) The Findings and Recommendations were adopted on August 2, 2017, and Plaintiff was 24 ordered to pay the full filing fee within twenty-one days. (Doc. 10.) Plaintiff was warned that the 25 failure to timely pay the fee would result in the dismissal of this case. (Id.) Approximately a 26 month has lapsed and Plaintiff has not paid the filing fee. Therefore, pursuant to the Court's 27 August 2, 2017 order and warning, this case will be dismissed and closed. 28

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. This case is DISMISSED without prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to pay the requisite \$400 filing fee; The pending motion for a temporary restraining order (Doc. 6) is DENIED as 2. moot; and 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to CLOSE this case. IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: September 18, 2017 SENIOR DISTRICT JUDGE
