Ratliff, 130 S.Ct. 2521 (2010). 27 Because counsel for Plaintiff was already awarded fees under 42 U.S.C. § 28 406(b) and the fees under the EAJA do not exceed the amount awarded under that

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1	statute, the \$6,000.00 awarded under 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d) will be paid directly to
2	Plaintiff if the fees are not subject to the Treasury's Offset Program. Costs in the
3	amount of \$400 will be paid to counsel for Plaintiff pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1920.
