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20 Based upon the parties’ Stipulation for the Award and Payment of Equal
 21 Access to Justice Act (EAJA) Fees and Costs, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff shall
 22 be awarded attorney fees under the EAJA in the amount of SIX THOUSAND
 23 DOLLARS (\$6,000.00), and costs under 28 U.S.C. § 1920, in the amount of
 24 FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00), subject to the terms of the above-
 25 referenced Stipulation, to include the United States Department of the Treasury’s
 26 Offset Program pursuant to *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 130 S.Ct. 2521 (2010).

27 Because counsel for Plaintiff was already awarded fees under 42 U.S.C. §
 28 406(b) and the fees under the EAJA do not exceed the amount awarded under that

1 statute, the \$6,000.00 awarded under 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d) will be paid directly to
2 Plaintiff if the fees are not subject to the Treasury's Offset Program. Costs in the
3 amount of \$400 will be paid to counsel for Plaintiff pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1920.
