20	Amendment of the complaint is governed by Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Civil		
21	Procedure which provides that a party may amend the party's pleading once as a matter of course		
22	at any time before a responsive pleading is served. Otherwise, a party may amend only by leave		
23	of the court or by written consent of the adverse party, and leave shall be freely given when		
24	justice so requires. Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a).		
25	Plaintiff has previously filed a complaint which is allowed as matter of course and		
26	therefore must either get the written consent of the opposing party or seek leave from the Court		
27	to file a second amended complaint. Plaintiff did not file a written stipulation to amend nor was		
28	leave sought from the Court to file a second amended complaint.
