13	Plaintiff Guillermo Cruz Trujillo, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed this civil action on		
14	December 29, 2016. (ECF No. 1.) Plaintiff consented to magistrate judge jurisdiction. (ECF No. 5.)		
15	On January 19, 2017, the Court denied Plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis, and		
16	dismissed the action without prejudice, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). Judgment was entered		
17	accordingly and the action was closed. (ECF Nos. 8, 9.)		
18	On January 20, 2017, Plaintiff filed the instant motion requesting leave to supplement the		
19	complaint with additional exhibits pursuant to Local Rule 138(d). (ECF No. 10.) As this action has		
20	been dismissed and the case closed, Plaintiff's motion is moot.		
21	Nonetheless, the Court has reviewed the exhibits submitted and finds that they would not alter		
22	the Court's ruling on January 19, 2017.		
23	Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion for permission to supplement his complaint with exhibits		
24	pursuant to Local Rule 138(d), filed on January 20, 2017, is HEREBY DENIED.
