18	This action was filed on January 4, 2017. On January 6, 2017, the scheduling order	
19	issued requiring "The administrative record shall only be filed electronically and, to the	
20	extent practicable, provided in Optical Character Recognition ("OCR") format." (ECF No.	
21	5 at 2:5-8 (emphasis in original).)	
22	On May 16, 2017, in Davis v. Commissioner of Social Security, 1:16-cv-00777-SAB, the	
23	Court recognized that beginning around October 2016, the administrative records were often not	
24	filed in OCR format in Social Security cases. The Court issued an order requiring the	
25	Commissioner of Social Security to file a copy of the administrative record in OCR format in	
26	that action and verify that the transcripts in all actions pending before the undersigned have been	
27	filed in the correct format. That order was to apply to all future social security cases before the	
28	undersigned unless otherwise ordered.	

1	On June 2, 2017, the Commissioner filed the administrative record in the instant case.	
2	(ECF No. 10.) However, it is not in OCR format. The Court shall require the Commissioner to	
3	file a copy of the administrative record in OCR format in this action.	
4	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within seven (7) days from the date of	
5	service of this order, the Commissioner shall file a copy of the administrative record in OCR	
6	format in this action.
