On January 30, 2017, the Court 21 granted Petitioner's motion for stay and abeyance of federal proceedings while he returned to 22 state court to exhaust his state remedies. (Doc. 13.) The case has been stayed and held in 23 abeyance since that time. 24 On July 16, 2019, Petitioner filed a motion to lift the stay and abeyance. (Doc. 28.) Petitioner states he has fully exhausted his state remedies with respect to the claims he seeks to 25 26 raise. In support, Petitioner attaches a copy of an order from the California Supreme Court denying a petition for writ of habeas corpus on June 12, 2019. (Doc. 29 at 5.) Because it appears 27

that Petitioner has exhausted his state remedies, the Court will lift the stay.

On July 16, 2019, Petitioner also lodged an amended petition and filed a motion to exceed page limits. (Docs. 29, 30.) Petitioner states he was unable to obtain a typewriter to type his amended petition; therefore, he handwrote the petition which required additional pages. He also states he is taking psychotropic medications which cause trembling arms and hands, which in turn cause his handwriting to be sloppy and space-consuming. Good cause having been presented, and good cause appearing therefor, his motion to extend page limitations will be granted and the amended petition will be filed. ORDER Based on the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: 1) Petitioner's motion to lift the stay (Doc. 28) is GRANTED; 2) Petitioner's motion to extend page limits (Doc. 29) is GRANTED; and 3) The Clerk of Court is DIRECTED to FILE the lodged amended petition (Doc. 30) as Petitioner's First Amended Petition.
