¹ Plaintiff's complaint is submitted on the court's form-application for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 which is used by state prisoners challenging their confinement or duration thereof. See Nettles v. Grounds, 830 F.3d 922, 927 (9th Cir. 2016). However, to the extent plaintiff states any claim upon which relief might be granted, plaintiff challenges the conditions at his place of confinement. While plaintiff asks for release from prison as a result of the conditions of his confinement, nothing suggests an adequate remedy would be, at most, transfer to a different prison.
