10	(i) Minors' names: In criminal actions, use the minors' initials; in civil
11	actions use initials when federal or state law require the use of initials, or when the specific identity of the minor is not necessary to the action or
12	individual document; (ii) Financial account numbers: Identify the name or type of account and
13	the financial institution where maintained, but use only the last four numbers of the account number;
14	(iii) Social Security numbers: Use only the last four numbers;
15	<ul><li>(iv) Dates of birth: Use only the year;</li><li>(v) Home addresses in criminal actions only; use only the city and state;</li></ul>
16	and (vi) All other circumstances: Redact when federal law requires redaction.
