I am writing to you in the hopes that you will be able to help me. I have been an inmate here at the Stanislaus County men's jail for the past 4 1/2 years. and during that time I have been working with operations here at the jail doing upkeep, maintenance, and refurbishing numerous areas around the jail. This jail is over 60 years old and has lead paint and asbestos material through out the jail. Concerning the lead paint in the course of refurbishing all metal window frames, door frames, and all metal doors through out the jail

my job was to scrape, sand, and grind all existing 60 year old lead paint from all metal work through out the jail. which caused air born dust from lead paint. and also numerous welding projects where I was exposed to burning paint fumes by welding on metal that contained lead paint. no PPE respirator provided

Concerning exposure to asbestos I have removed over 2000sf of asbestos tile, asbestos rapped pipes asbestos vinyl floor tile and black vinyl floor glue. all of this material dates back to 1950 once again I was never provided proper PPE respirator

my Supervisor and operations knew of the dangers of me being exposed to asbestos and also lead paint and I was not aware at the time of the dangers until much later.

I have had two work related injuries do to unsafe working conditions, the first injury happened when I was coming down from the roof of the jail and the ladder collapsed due to a faulty ladder causing me to hit my left leg with such force my leg swell so much, the medical department here at the jail cut my leg open to release the swelling and in doing so caused my leg to get so infected it has left the whole lower part of my left leg with permanent disfigurement and constant pain the medical staff here at the jail should never cut open my leg. Beings it was work related I should have been taken directly to a workmens Comp Doctor outside of the jail

my second injury is a hernia I received while working here at the jail. which is causing me pain. its been over a year and jail refuses to do surgery to repair damage even after the specialist told the jail surger is mandatory to repair damage. I have been experiencing on going headaches and respiratory problems which I dont know if its caused by being exposed to asbestos and lead paint

I am not receiving proper medical treatment for these symptoms and for my injuries which occurred while working here at the Stanislaus County Jail. I have all documentation from medical refusing me treatment.

I have all documentation of projects and of areas where I was exposed to asbestos and lead paint. I am writing to you because of the seriousness of my injuries and physical well being. I have no where to turn to for the assistance I am in need of. The jail is not allowing me access to attorneys so I am able to protect my rights and to assist me with getting the medical treatment for my injuries.

I understand you are not able to give me any legal advice. What I am requesting is a list of Civil attorneys and/or referees so I am able to contact an attorney phone # addresses to protect my rights and also I am requesting all necessary forms so that I am able to file a Civil suit for my injuries. I have over 3000 documented hours I have worked. There were many days I was forced to work 16 hrs days (10 days in a row when working on special projects).

when I started making complaints about me not receiving proper medical treatment by a workman's Comp Doctor. the operations Sergeant made it clear that if I continued to push the issue, he could see to it that my stay here was extended. or find myself some-where where I didn't want to be, these were threats made and carried out.

I was never able to understand what the problem was. if I was injured while working for the County. there should be no question about me being taken to a workman's Comp Doctor. But I was told in confidence by a Deputy that the problem with my injury wasn't because they didn't want to take me to be seen by workman's Comp Doctor. it was because a report would have to be made, and turned over to Risk management and once an investigation was done and it was shown that an inmate worker was on top of the 4 story jail roof without a safety harness and was injured. the jail, and the County along with the operations sergeant would be in some very serious trouble.

Because of the seriousness of what's happened and the threat it pose.

The jail administration along with the jail Commander and operations sergeant have made it impossible for me to receive any type of legal assistance so I am able to pursue my Civil suit and to seek legal representation to protect my legal rights.

At least by me contacting and making the Court aware of what is being done to me, I will have proof that I tried to do something to protect myself.
