COPIES
(Doc. 34)

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On July 29, 2019, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting copies of memorandums, orders, and judgments issued in this case. (Doc. 34.) Payment for copies must be made in advance at the cost of \$0.50 per page.¹ Plaintiff must specifically identify the documents he wants copied and submit prepayment. Accordingly, Plaintiff’s motion for copies, filed on July 29, 2019, (Doc. 34), is DENIED without prejudice.
