Gonzales has filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 17 § 1983. Before the Court is a February 27, 2017 motion to proceed in forma pauperis 18 filed by an individual named Tara Jones. 19 Ms. Jones is not a party to this action. Her application to proceed in forma 20 pauperis, representing her own financial circumstances, has no bearing on Plaintiff's 21 ability to proceed in forma pauperis in this action. Furthermore, Ms. Jones does not 22 appear to be an attorney, and thus is prohibited from representing Plaintiff in this action 23 or appearing on his behalf. C.E. Pope Equity Trust v. United States, 818 F.2d 696, 697 24 (9th Cir.1987) (holding that a pro se litigant may not appear as an attorney for others); 25 Welch v. Terhune, 11 F. App'x 747, 747 (9th Cir. 2001) (same). 26 Based on the foregoing, it is HEREBY ORDERED that: 27 1. The motion to proceed in forma pauperis is HEREBY DENIED 28

2	2. The Clerk's Office shall send plaintiff a regular civil in forma		
3		pauperis application	on;
4	3. Within thirty (30) days from the date of service of this order, Plaintif		
5		shall either file a c	ompleted regular civil in forma pauperis
6	application or pay the \$400.00 filing fee in full.		
7	If Plaintiff fails to obey this order, the undersigned will recommend dismissal of		
8	this action.
