16 Before the Court is the parties' Stipulation to Partially Revise the Court's Scheduling Order.  
17 (Doc. 12.) The parties indicate that Plaintiff's counsel has not yet been able to complete the  
18 necessary non-expert discovery in this case, as Plaintiff's counsel has been assisting those impacted  
19 by the fires in Sonoma and Napa, California. The parties further indicate that they would like to  
20 resolve certain issues related to written discovery (they anticipate the issues will resolve shortly)  
21 prior to the taking of depositions, which the parties anticipate scheduling after February 2018.

22 Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b)(4), and for good cause shown, IT IS HEREBY  
23 ORDERED that the Scheduling Order be modified as follows:
