21 John Williams (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis*
22 with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On March 3, 2017, Plaintiff filed the
23 Complaint commencing this action. (ECF No. 1.)

24 On October 3, 2017, the court issued an order dismissing Plaintiff’s Complaint for
25 failure to state a claim, with leave to file an amended complaint within thirty days. (ECF No.
26 9.) The thirty-day deadline has now expired, and Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint
27 or otherwise responded to the court’s order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets
28 forth any claims upon which relief may be granted.
