Nos. 33, 36) 14 15 Jesse Washington ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis 16 17 in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Erica P. Grosjean pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 18 On March 8, 2018, H. Gamboa and R. Roque ("Defendants") filed a motion for judgment 19 on the pleading as to all state law claims asserted in this action. (Doc. No. 33). Plaintiff did not 20 oppose the motion. (Doc. No. 35). On May 1, 2018, the Magistrate Judge issued findings and 21 22 recommendations, recommending that Defendants' motion for judgment on the pleadings be granted. (Doc. No. 36). The findings and recommendations directed the parties to file any 23 objections within fourteen days of service thereof. Id. The fourteen-day period has expired, and 24 no party has filed objections. 25

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.
