On June 26, 2017, Defendant Trans Union, LLC filed a first amended stipulation dismissing this action with prejudice against Trans Union, LLC only with each party to bear its own costs and fees. Rule 41(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure allows a party to dismiss some or all of the defendants or claims in an action through a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.
