[PROPOSED] ORDER

28 The Court, having read and considered the Stipulation Regarding Final
Distribution of Settlement, and finding good cause, hereby orders as follows:

1. The Court authorizes a second distribution in which the remaining Net
Settlement Fund (less a \$5,239.76 administration expense) shall be distributed to the
Settlement Class Members who did not cash their first-distribution checks. These
second-distribution checks to Settlement Class Members shall be in the same amount
as their first-distribution checks. The Court authorizes a payment of \$5,239.76 to the

1 Settlement Administrator from the Net Settlement Fund for the expense of the second
2 distribution. The checks for the second distribution shall be valid for sixty (60) days
3 after mailing, after which point the checks shall be void and not reissued and the
4 remaining funds sent to the cy pres recipient.
