16	Before the Court is Plaintiff's Reques	st for Extension of Time to File Amended Complaint	
17	7 (the "Motion"), ¹ in which Plaintiff requests (1) "a 120 day extension of time" to file an amended		
18	8 complaint, and (2) that the Court "clarify the reasons for its dismissal" of Plaintiff's prior		
19	9 complaint. (Doc. 6.) As to Plaintiff's first request, the Court finds that an extension is warranted,		
20	although not the full 120 days requested by Plaintiff. The Court therefore GRANTS IN PART the		
21	Motion, (Doc. 6), and ORDERS that Plaintiff may file an amended complaint, if he so chooses, by		
22	no later than thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.		
23	Regarding Plaintiff's second request, the Court finds that its April 24, 2017 order		
24	adequately described the deficiencies in Plair	ntiff's prior complaint. In particular, the Court directs

1	Plaintiff's attention to the requirements of a claim for disparate pay under the Equal Pay Act, (see
2	Doc. 3 at 5–6), as well as the specific deficiencies in Plaintiff's prior Complaint, (see id. at 6–7).
3	The Court therefore DENIES the Motion, (Doc. 6), insofar as Plaintiff requests further
4	clarification of the Court's April 24, 2017 order.
