20	summary judgment " Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A). Once such a notice has been filed, an order of the	
21	Court is not required to make the dismissal effective. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(ii); <u>Wilson v. City of San</u>	
22	Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Accordingly, the Clerk of Court is DIRECTED to close this	
23	action in light of the notice of dismissal with prejudice filed and properly signed pursuant to Rule 41(a).
