



1 extension of time to be a motion by Defendant to amend the Scheduling Order.

2 In making the request to amend the schedule, Defendant fails to identify *any* reason to support  
3 the requested extension. (*See* Doc. 20) Consequently, the Court is unable to find that good cause exists  
4 to support the request. However, the request was filed only three days before the brief was due, and  
5 Plaintiff does not oppose modification of the briefing schedule. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS**:

- 6 1. The request for an extension of time is **GRANTED IN PART**;
- 7 2. Defendant **SHALL** file a response to the opening brief no later than **March 15, 2018**; and
- 8 3. The parties are reminded that any additional requests for extensions of time **SHALL** be  
9 supported by good cause.
