Currently 14 the action is proceeding on the third amended complaint against Cody Gunsolley and Eric 15 Pearson. On September 17, 2019, a notice of voluntary dismissal was filed dismissing the action 16 with prejudice as to Defendant Gunsolley with each party to bear its own costs and attorney fees. 17 (ECF No. 52.) 18 Rule 41(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure allows a party to dismiss some or all 19 of the defendants in an action through a Rule 41(a) notice. Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111 F.3d 20 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997).
