18	On April 12, 2017, Petitioner United States of America filed a petition to enforce an Internal	
19	Revenue Service summons. (ECF No. 1.) Respondent did not appear for an order to show cause	
20	hearing and on July 18, 2017, an order enforcing the summons was issued. (ECF Nos. 7, 9.) On April	
21	27, 2018, Petitioner filed a notice of voluntary dismissal pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1) of the Federal Rules	
22	of Civil Procedure.	
23	"[U]nder Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(i), 'a plaintiff has an absolute right to voluntarily dismiss his action	
24	prior to service by the defendant of an answer or a motion for summary judgment." <u>Commercial Space</u>

Mgmt. Co., Inc. v. Boeing Co., Inc., 193 F.3d 1074, 1077 (9th Cir. 1999) (quoting Wilson v. City of San

Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997)). The Ninth Circuit has held that Rule 41(a) allows a plaintiff to

dismiss without a court order any defendant who has yet to serve an answer or motion for summary

judgment. Pedrina v. Chun, 987 F.2d 608, 609 (9th Cir. 1993). "[A] dismissal under Rule 41(a)(1) is

1	effective on filing, no court order is required, the parties are left as though no action had been brought,	
2	the defendant can't complain, and the district court lacks jurisdiction to do anything about it."	
3	Commercial Space Mgmt. Co., Inc., 193 F.3d at 1078.	
4	Accordingly, the Clerk of the Court is HEREBY ORDERED to CLOSE the file in this case and	
5	adjust the docket to reflect voluntary dismissal of this action pursuant to Rule 41(a).
