(Doc. 19). Accordingly, the case 17 shall proceed pursuant to the procedures set forth in this Court's Scheduling order issued on August 30, 18 2017. (Doc. 15). For clarity, the deadlines and further instructions for this case are outlined as follows: 19 1) Defendant shall file the administrative record no later than **February 23, 2018**. 20 2) Within thirty (30) days after service of the administrative record, Plaintiff shall serve on 21 Defendant a letter brief outlining the reasons why he/she contends that a remand is warranted. 22 The letter brief shall succinctly set forth the relevant issues and reasons for the remand. **The** 23 letter brief itself shall NOT be filed with the court and it shall be marked "confidential." A 24 separate proof of service reflecting that the letter brief was served on Defendant shall be filed 25 with the court. 26 3) Within thirty-five (35) days after service of Plaintiff's letter brief, Defendant shall serve a 27 response to Plaintiff's letter brief on Plaintiff. The response itself shall NOT be filed 28

1	stipulation of the parties. Court approval is not required for this extension. However, the
2	stipulation shall be filed with the court.
3	10) Request for modification of this briefing schedule will not routinely be granted.
4	11) With the exception of the single thirty day extension, requests to modify this order must be
5	made by written motion and will be granted only for good cause.
6	12) Violations of this order or of the federal or local rules of procedure may result in sanctions
7	pursuant to Local Rule 110.
8	13) Defendant is reminded that because Plaintiff is <i>pro se</i> , she is not a registered used of CM/ECl
9	Therefore, any documents filed with the Court must be served on Plaintiff via first class mail.
10	
11	It is recommended that Plaintiff seek the advice of an attorney. Plaintiff is advised that
12	if she does not retain an attorney to represent her, she is responsible for complying with
13	all Court rules and applicable laws. A failure to timely comply with any order of this
14	Court (including this order) will result in dismissal of the action.
