17	James Bowell ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in		
18	this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States		

Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On October 3, 2018, the court entered <u>findings and recommendations</u>, recommending that this action proceed against defendants Montoya and Carter for violation of due process under the Fourteenth Amendment, and against defendants Killmer and Lopez for conspiracy to place Plaintiff at risk of serious harm, and for failure to protect Plaintiff under the Eighth Amendment; and that all other claims and defendants be dismissed from this action based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim. (ECF No. 18.) On October 15, 2018, Plaintiff filed <u>objections</u> to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 19.)

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this
court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file,

including Plaintiff's objections, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis. 

3	Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:	
4	1.	This case now proceeds against defendants Montoya and Carter for violation of
5		due process under the Fourteenth Amendment, and against defendants Killmer
6		and Lopez conspiracy to place Plaintiff at risk of serious harm, and for failure to
7		protect Plaintiff under the Eighth Amendment;
8	2.	All other claims and defendants are dismissed from this action, based on
9		Plaintiff's failure to state a claim;
10	3.	Plaintiff's claims under criminal law statutes, for making false reports, for
11		retaliation, and for violation of equal protection are dismissed from this action,
12		based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim;
13	4.	Defendants Doser and Hart are dismissed from this action, based on Plaintiff's
14		failure to state any claims against them;
15	5.	The Clerk is directed to reflect the dismissal of defendants Doser and Hart on the
16		court's docket; and
17	6.	This case is referred back to the Magistrate Judge, for further proceedings
18		including initiation of service of process.
