17 The Court previously granted Plaintiff's motions for the issuance of a subpoena upon
18 the California Department of Motor Vehicles. (ECF No. 44). Plaintiff has now completed and
19 returned the subpoena and form USM-285. (ECF No. 45).¹

20 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 21 1. The Clerk of the Court shall forward the following documents to the United States
22 Marshals Service:
- 23 a. One (1) completed and issued subpoena *duces tecum*, including the attachments
 - 24 (ECF No. 45);
 - 25 b. One (1) completed USM-285 form (ECF No. 45); and
 - 26 c. Two (2) copies of this order, one to accompany the subpoena and one for the

1 United States Marshals Service.

- 2 2. Within TWENTY (20) DAYS from the date of this order, the United States
3 Marshals Service SHALL effect personal service of the subpoena, along with a copy
4 of this order, upon the entity named in the subpoena pursuant to Rule 45 of the
5 Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and 28 U.S.C. § 566(c).
- 6 3. The United States Marshals Service is DIRECTED to retain a copy of the subpoena
7 in its file for future use.
- 8 4. Within TEN (10) DAYS after personal service is effected, the United States
9 Marshals Service SHALL file the return of service.

10 IT IS SO ORDERED.
