PREJUDICE FOR FAILURE TO PAY FILING 14 SHERYLL, 15 Defendant. 16 17 Manuel Herrera-Garcia is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with this civil rights action 18 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge 19 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302 of the United States District Court for 20 the Eastern District of California. 21 On November 27, 2017, the court adopted the assigned magistrate judge's findings and 22 recommendations recommending that plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis be denied without prejudice. (Doc. No. 13.) Plaintiff was ordered to pay the \$400 filing fee in full within 23 24 thirty days of the date of issuance of that order, or to submit a renewed application to proceed in 25 forma pauperis clarifying plaintiff's financial condition and adequately demonstrating financial 26 hardship. (Id. at 2.) 27 Far more than thirty days have passed following the issuance of the November 27, 2017 28 order, and plaintiff has failed to pay the required \$400 filing fee or submit a renewed application

to proceed in forma pauperis.
Accordingly:
1. This case is dismissed without prejudice due to plaintiff's failure to pay the required \$400
filing fee or submit a renewed application to proceed in forma pauperis; and
2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
IT IS SO ORDERED.
