27	advised that if he is unable to comply with a court order he must file a request for an extension of	
28	time prior to the expiration of the deadline.	

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1	Based on the foregoing, the February 20, 2018 order to show cause (ECF No. 17) is		
2	HEREBY DISCHARGED.
