Sienze is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights 18 action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Along with his complaint, Plaintiff filed an application to 19 20 proceed without prepayment of fees in this action. Plaintiff's application demonstrates entitlement to proceed without prepayment of fees. Notwithstanding this order, the Court does 21 not direct that service be undertaken until the Court screens the complaint in due course and 22 issues its screening order. 23

Along with his application, Plaintiff included federal income tax information which

contains his Social Security number. The Court shall direct the Clerk of the Court to seal this

page due to the confidential nature of the information.
