service for an appropriate period. This subdivision (m) does not apply to service in a foreign country under Rule 4(f), 4(h)(2), or 4(j)(1).

Nevertheless, Plaintiff has not filed a proof of service of the summons and complaint as to any defendant. Therefore, the Court **ORDERS**,

1. **No later than August 11, 2017**, the plaintiff **SHALL** show cause why sanctions should not be imposed for the failure to serve and file proofs of service on the defendants.

Alternatively, the plaintiff may file proofs of service;

2. Due the failure of the plaintiff to serve the summonses and complaint, the scheduling conference, currently set on August 15, 2017 is **CONTINUED** to **September 29, 2017** at 8:30 a.m.

Plaintiff is reminded of the service obligations under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4. Failure to comply may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of unserved defendants.
