Plaintiff did not pay the filing fee in this action and instead 16 filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. However, 17 Plaintiff's application was not adequately completed. Plaintiff's application does not reflect all 18 the amount of income which is being received by his household. For that reason, the Court is 19 unable to determine if he is able to proceed in this action without prepayment of fees. 20 Accordingly, the Court will order Plaintiff to complete and file an Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs (Long Form) - AO 239. If Plaintiff is 21 unwilling to complete and submit the long form application, Plaintiff must pay the filing fee in 22 full. 23 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: 24 1. The Clerk of the Court is directed to forward an in forma pauperis application 25 (Long Form) to Plaintiff; 26 2. Within twenty (20) days of the date of this order, Plaintiff shall either (1) pay the 27 \$400.00 filing fee for this action, or (2) file an application to proceed in forma 28

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1	pauperis without prepayment of the fee; and		
2	3.	If Plaintiff fails to con	apply with this order, this action shall be dismissed.
