**ORDER DENYING PARTIES’  
STIPULATION TO AMEND BRIEFING  
SCHEDULE FOR MOTIONS IN  
LIMINE**

14 This lawsuit is about four renters who allege that they were treated unlawfully by their  
15 landlords. The trial in this lawsuit is scheduled to begin on February 5, 2019. See Doc. No. 41.  
16 The deadline for the parties to file motions in limine is January 4, 2019. See id.

17 Before the Court is the parties’ joint stipulation to amend the motions in limine briefing  
18 schedule. See Doc. No. 43. In their joint stipulation, the parties propose the following briefing  
19 schedule:

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25 The parties assert that good cause exists for their proposed briefing schedule because the  
26 parties are scheduled to participate in a settlement conference with Magistrate Judge Thurston on  
27 January 7, 2019, and “it will increase the chance of settlement to conserve costs by postponing the  
28 preparation of motions in limine until after the settlement conference.” Doc. No. 43-1.
