PFEIFFER, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 Carlton Callins ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis 17 in this civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On November 22, 2019, Defendants 18 19 filed a motion for summary judgment. (ECF No. 51). The Court gave Plaintiff until December 20, 2019, to file an opposition. (ECF No. 48, p. 2). The deadline for Plaintiff to respond to the 20 motion has passed, and Plaintiff has not filed an opposition or a statement of non-opposition. 21 Local Rule 230(1) provides that the failure "to file an opposition or to file a statement of 22 no opposition may be deemed a waiver of any opposition to the granting of the motion and may 23 result in the imposition of sanctions." While a motion for summary judgment cannot be granted 24 by default, Heinemann v. Satterberg, 731 F.3d 914, 916 (9th Cir. 2013), the Court does have other 25 options when a party fails to respond. For example, if Plaintiff fails to respond, the Court may 26

1	opposition, the Court may recommend that this case be dismissed for failure to prosecute and
2	failure to comply with court orders.
3	Accordingly, based on the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
4	1. Within thirty days from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff shall file an
5	opposition or a statement of non-opposition <sup>1</sup> to Defendants' motion for summary
6	judgment;
7	2. If Plaintiff fails to comply with this order, in ruling on Defendants' motion for
8	summary judgment the Court may treat the facts asserted by Defendants in their
9	motion for summary judgment as undisputed. Alternatively, the Court may
10	recommend that this case be dismissed for failure to prosecute and failure to
11	comply with court orders; and
12	3. If Plaintiff files an opposition to Defendants' motion for summary judgment,
13	Defendants have fourteen days from the date of service of the opposition to file a
14	reply.
