20	under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to	
21	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
22	On November 14, 2018, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein	
23	which were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the	
24	findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has not filed	
25	objections to the findings and recommendations.	
26	The Court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be	
27	supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY  ORDERED that:

1	1. The findings and recommendations filed November 14, 2018 (ECF No. 11), are
2	adopted in full;
3	2. This action shall proceed only on plaintiff's Eighth Amendment claim against
4	defendant Jane Doe. All other claims and defendants are dismissed; and
5	3. This case is referred back to the magistrate judge for further proceedings.
