THIRTY (30) DAY DEADLINE 16 17 Plaintiff Gerald Stewart ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma 18 19 pauperis in this civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff initiated this action on July 7, 2017, (ECF No. 1), and has consented to magistrate judge jurisdiction. (ECF No. 7.) 20 The Court is required to screen complaints brought by prisoners seeking relief against a 21 governmental entity and/or against an officer or employee of a governmental entity. 28 U.S.C. 22 § 1915A(a). In preparing to screen the complaint, the Court notes Plaintiff's complaint lacks any 23 signature. Both the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and this Court's Local Rules require that all 24 filed pleadings, motions and papers be signed by at least one attorney of record or by the party 25 personally if the party is unrepresented. Fed. R. Civ. P. 11(a); Local Rule 131(b). Since 26 Plaintiff's complaint is unsigned, the Court must strike it from the record. Plaintiff will be 27 permitted thirty (30) days to file a signed complaint that complies with Federal Rules of Civil

| 5  | 2. The Clerk's Office SHALL send to Plaintiff a civil rights complaint form;                      |
| 6  | 3. Within <b>thirty</b> (30) days from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff SHALL file    |
| 7  | a complaint or a notice of voluntary dismissal; and   |
| 8  | 4. <u>If Plaintiff fails to file a complaint in compliance with this order, the Court</u>         |
| 9  | will dismiss this action, with prejudice, for failure to state a claim, failure to prosecute, and |
| 10 | failure to obey a court order.  |
