19	Within forty-five (45) days of the date of service of this order, Plaintiff shall submit	
20	the attached application to proceed in forma pauperis as a prisoner, completed and	
21	signed, or in the alternative, pay the \$400.00 filing fee for this action. No requests for	
22	extension will be granted without a showing of good cause. Failure to comply	
23	with this order will result in dismissal of this action.
