The Court finds that the Government has met its 14 burden of exercising reasonable diligence pursuant to Rules 4(e)(1) and 4(m) of the Federal 15 Rules of Civil Procedure and § 415.50 of the California Code of Civil Procedure, and, for good 16 cause shown, the Government's motion to serve Defendant Doerr by publication is **GRANTED**. 17 (See generally Doc. 10; see also Doc. 14.) Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the 18 Government may effect service of the summons and complaint in this action on Defendant Doerr 19 by publication pursuant to § 415.50 of the California Code of Civil Procedure and by posting a 20 copy of the summons and complaint at the gate or door of the real property that is the subject of 21 this litigation. 22 23 24

1	Further, for good cause shown, the Government's request for an extension of time to
2	effect service on Defendant Doerr is <b>GRANTED</b> . Accordingly, it is hereby <b>ORDERED</b> that the
3	service of process deadline is extended from January 15, 2018, to March 15, 2018.
