1	These statements should neither be filed on the docket nor served on any other party. The statements	
2	should be marked "CONFIDENTIAL" and should state the date and time of the conference. The	
3	statements should not be lengthy but should include (1) a brief recitation of the facts; (2) a discussion	
4	of the strengths and weaknesses of the case; (3) an itemized estimate of the expected costs for further	
5	pretrial and trial matters; (4) an estimate of recovery should this case proceed to trial; and (5) a candid	
6	statement of the party's position on settlement, including a history of settlement discussions, any	
7	current settlement offers from any party, expectations for settlement discussions, and <b>the amount that</b>	
8	<b>the party will accept to settle</b> ; and (6) a list of the individuals who will be attending the settlement on	
9	the party's behalf.	
10	Magistrate Judge Jeremy D. Peterson will hold a short, pre-settlement conference telephone	
11	discussion on <b>January 23, 2019</b> at 3:00 p.m. (dial-in number: 1-888-204-5984; passcode: 4446176).	
12	Only the lead attorney from each side should participate.
