(ECF No. 7) 17 TWENTY-ONE (21) DAY DEADLINE 18 19 Plaintiff Raymond Alford Bradford is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil 20 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. 21 22 On January 18, 2017, the Court found that Plaintiff's complaint failed to state a cognizable claim for relief and granted plaintiff thirty days to file an amended complaint 23 addressing the deficiencies identified by the Court. (ECF No. 9.) More than thirty days have 24 25 passed, and Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the order. Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that within twenty-one (21) days from the date 26

of service of this order, Plaintiff shall show cause in writing why the action should not be

dismissed. Plaintiff is warned that the failure to comply with this order will result in a

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recommendation to a district judge that the action be dismissed for failure to comply with a court order and failure to state a cognizable claim for relief. IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: March 2, 2018 UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE
