

28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2). The Sheriff of Kings County, or its designee, is required to send payments from Plaintiff's trust account to the Clerk of the Court each time the amount in the account exceeds \$10.00 until the statutory filing fee is paid in full. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2).

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis* is GRANTED;
- 2. Within sixty (60) days of the date of service of this order, Plaintiff shall submit a certified copy of his inmate trust account statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint, if Plaintiff has not already done so;
- 3. The Sheriff of Kings County or his designee shall collect payments from Plaintiff's inmate trust account in an amount equal to twenty per cent (20%) of the preceding month's income credited to the inmate's trust account and shall forward those payments to the Clerk of Court each time the amount in the account exceeds \$10.00, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §1915(b)(2), until a total of \$350.00 has been collected and forwarded to the Clerk of Court. The payments shall be clearly identified by the name and number assigned to this action;
- 4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this Order and a copy of Plaintiff's *in forma pauperis* application on the Sheriff of Kings County, via mail at 1444 W. Lacey Blvd. Hanford, CA 93230; and
- 5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the Financial Department, U.S. District Court, Eastern District of California.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
