16	Plaintiff Ryan James Johnson is appearing pro se and in forma paueris in this civil rights action	
17	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.	
18	On August 15, 2018, the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss this action with prejudice	
19	pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, as the case has been resolved	
20	in its entirety. (ECF No. 26.)	
21	Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) provides in pertinent part that, "the plaintiff may dismiss an action without	
22	a court order by filing a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared. A	
23	voluntary stipulation to dismiss an action pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) automatically terminates the	
24	action without operation of a court order." <u>Black Rock City, LLC v. Pershing Cty. Bd. of Comm'rs</u> ,	
25	637 F. App'x 488 (9th Cir. 2016) (citing <u>Commercial Space Mgmt. Co. v. Boeing Co</u> ., 193 F.3d 1074,	
26	1077 (9th Cir. 1999)). Here, Plaintiff and counsel for Defendant have signed and dated a stipulation to	
27	dismiss this action, and filed it with the Court.	
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In light of parties' stipulation for voluntary dismissal, this action is terminated by operation of law without further order from the Court. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). Each party is to bear its own litigation costs and attorney's fees. The Clerk of the Court is directed to terminate all pending motions and deadlines and close this action.
