17	Plaintiff initiated this action by filing a complaint on September 14, 2017. (Doc. 1) As a	
18	general rule, all parties instituting any civil action, suit or proceeding in a United States District Court	
19	must pay a filing fee. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). However, the Court may authorize the commencement of	
20	an action without the filing fee "by a person who submits an affidavit that includes a statement of all	
21	assets such [person] possesses that the person is unable to pay such fees or give security therefore." 28	
22	U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1). Therefore, an action may proceed despite a failure to prepay the filing fee only if	
23	leave to proceed in forma pauperis is granted by the Court. See Rodriguez v. Cook, 169 F.3d 1176,	
24	1177 (9th Cir. 1999).	
25	Plaintiff failed to pay the requisite filing fee or to file a motion to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> ,	
26	and the matter cannot proceed before the Court at this time. Accordingly, the Court ORDERS :	
27		fee or file a motion to proceed in forma pauperis within
28	21 days of service.
