**ORDER RE: RESPONSE TO ORDER TO

On July 11, 2018, the Court issued an order to show cause (ECF No. 13), requiring Plaintiff to show cause why the action should not be dismissed in light of Plaintiff's failure to file an opening brief within the time required under the Court's scheduling order (ECF No. 6-1).
