20	States District Judge Dale A. Drozd, Courtroom 5, 7th Floor, 2500 Tulare Street, Fresno, CA	
21	93721, on Tuesday, April 17, 2018, at 9:30 a.m., and that respondent show cause as follows:	
22	1. Why respondent should not be held in civil contempt of this court due to her	
23	failure to comply with the order issued in this action on January 18, 2018 (Doc. No. 11) directing	
24	respondent to comply with the IRS Summons issued on January 24, 2017; and	
25	2. Why respondent should not be incarcerated and ordered to pay a daily fine until	
26	she complies with the court's order of January 18, 2018 (Doc. No. 11), and also be ordered to pay	
27	a compensatory fine to the United States.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within seven (7) calendar days after the filing of this order, the respondent shall file and serve a written response to the order issued January 18, 2018 (Doc. No. 11). Only those issues brought into controversy by the responsive papers and supported by declaration will be considered at the hearing on this order to show cause, and any uncontested allegation in the petition will be considered admitted. Respondent is hereby notified that a failure to comply with this order will subject respondent to possible further sanctions for contempt of court.¹ IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: **March 15, 2018**
