FOURTEEN-DAY DEADLINE

On January 22, 2018, Plaintiff filed a motion to stay this action due to the shutdown of the operations of the federal government and the lapse in appropriations and to extend all deadlines until ten business days after the shutdown is lifted. On this same date, President Trump signed a short term funding bill ending the federal government shutdown.
