Garcia ("Plaintiff") is a county jail inmate appearing pro se in this civil 18 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff initiated this action on October 2, 2017. 19 20 (ECF No. 1.) That same day, Plaintiff filed a motion to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 21 U.S.C. § 1915. (ECF No. 2.) 22 Plaintiff has made the showing required by § 1915(a) and accordingly, the request to proceed in forma pauperis will be granted. Plaintiff is obligated to pay the statutory filing fee of 23 24 \$350.00 for this action. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(1). Plaintiff is obligated to make monthly payments in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the preceding month's income credited to Plaintiff's 25 26 trust account. The Kings County Sheriff's Department is required to send to the Clerk of the 27 Court payments from Plaintiff's trust account each time the amount in the account exceeds 28 \$10.00, until the statutory filing fee is paid in full. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2). 1
