**ORDER DIRECTING  
SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFING**

In reviewing the above-captioned case, the Court has reviewed *Barnes v. Berryhill*, 895 F.3d 702 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2018), which appears to have application to Plaintiff’s first issue contending that the Administrative Law Judge erred in failing to identify Plaintiff’s transferable skills. Accordingly, Plaintiff is hereby directed to prepare a supplemental memorandum of law, not to exceed ten (10) pages, addressing the application, if any, of *Barnes* to her allegations of error. Such brief shall be submitted on or before March 8, 2019. Thereafter, Defendant may file a supplemental response, not to exceed ten (10) pages, within ten (10) days of Plaintiff’s filing of her supplemental brief.
